

The Town of Pecos City, TX is soliciting eight (8) proposals for equipment in support of the City's Wastewater System Improvements Project, with an individual Request for Proposals for each specific equipment package, including the following: Chemical Feed System, Grit Removal System, Membrane Bioreactor System, Mechanical Coarse Screening, Mechanical Fine Screening, Plant Water System, Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition System, and Solids Dewatering.

This contract or contracts are contingent upon release of funds from the Texas Water Development Board. Any contract or contracts awarded under these Request for Proposals are expected to be funded in part by financial assistance from the Texas Water Development Board. Neither the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) or the State of Texas, nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees, are or will be a party to this Invitation for Bids or any resulting contract.
