## CITY OF EASTLAND TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE (GLO) COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) MITIGATION (MIT) CONTRACT No. 22-082-004-D199 PHASE II – CREEK CHANNEL IMPROVEMENTS

#### Addendum No. 1

Attention is called to the following modifications to the referenced Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents for the above referenced project. The City of Eastland will receive sealed bids for the GLO Flood Mitigation Improvements Project until 2:00 p.m., local time on Thursday, December 5, 2024, at the Eastland City Hall, located at 113 E. Commerce, Eastland, Texas 76448. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at this time. We hereby modify the documents as follows:

#### **PROJECT MANUAL:**

#### 1. INVITATION FOR BIDS

- a. REVISE the project scope as follows:
  - Channel improvements of approximately 7,485 L.F. along the South Fork Leon River to the channel shall result in an increase of flow area to reduce impacts of flood events. Work items include but are not limited to regrading/shaping of the channel banks, removal of objectionable vegetation, and snagging (selective removal of snags, drifts, or other obstructions).

#### 2. BID FORM

a. **REPLACE** the Bid Form with the attached Bid Form.

#### 3. SECTION 01010 – SUMMARY OF WORK

- a. **REVISE** paragraph 1.1.A.a as follows:
  - Channel improvements of approximately 7,485 L.F. along the South Fork Leon River to the channel shall result in an increase of flow area to reduce impacts of flood events. Work items include but are not limited to regrading/shaping of the channel banks, removal of objectionable vegetation, and snagging (selective removal of snags, drifts, or other obstructions).

#### **DRAWINGS:**

1. **REPLACE** existing Drawing Sheets 1 through 8 with the attached revised Sheets 1 through 8.

#### **CLARIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Please refer to construction access routes shown on the Overall Project Layout (Sheet 02).
- 2. Construction access routes on the south side of the River are on the Hoffman and Truly properties. The Contractor will have to work east/west along the River from those points.
- On the south side of the River the existing fence between the Hoffman and Truly properties may be taken down for access. A temporary fence shall be installed and upon completion of the work the fence shall be re-built to as good or better condition.
- 4. On the south side of the River the existing fence between Hoffman and Winkler properties may be taken down for access. A temporary fence shall be installed and upon completion of the work the fence shall be re-built to as good or better condition.
- 5. The construction access route on the north side of the River is on the City of Eastland's WWTP property. The Contractor will have to work east/west along the River from that point.
- 6. On the north side of the River the existing fence between the City of Eastland and the Truly properties may be taken down for access. A temporary fence shall be installed and upon completion of the work the fence shall be re-built to as good or better condition.
- 7. On the north side of the River on the Winkler property, the Contractor shall plan to perform work by hand.
- 8. Please note additional construction access routes may be possible on the properties shown with prior approval of the property owner.

This addendum consists of **thirteen (13)** pages and becomes a part of the referenced plans, specifications and contract documents and shall be acknowledged by the bidder and attached to the bid packet submitted.

It is understood that the Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids. It is also understood that the Owner reserves the right to reject informalities in the bid proposal.




